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# You can use the short method if: Short Method? You can use the short method if: You made no estimated tax payments (or your only payments were withheld federal income tax), or You paid the same amount of estimated tax on each of the four payment due dates. Must You Use the Regular Method? You must use the regular method (Part IV) instead of the short method if: You made any estimated tax payments late, You checked box C or D in Part II, or You are filing Form 1040NR or 1040NR-EZ and you didn't receive wages as an employee subject to U.S. income tax withholding.

**Note:** If any payment was made earlier than the due date, you can use the short method, but using it may cause you to pay a larger penalty than the regular method. If the payment was only a few days early, the difference is likely to be small.
